The best way I can describe myself at work is as an intersection between a creative, artistic and sensitive designer – and a calculative, hyper thinking innovator and experienced production manager with a well founded understanding of both media production and IT development processes.

I have worked professionally in film and TV in London and Copenhagen and with software development and UX design in large organisations and enterprises. Furthermore, I have worked with my own team of software developers in my previous Danish enterprise 'Soft Easy Aps', as well as designing tailor made website solutions and specialised UX together with my customers over the past thirty years.

I successfully contribute to projects whose potential I see, and I always follow through to completion.

In the period 1999 to 2000 I received total funding of 250.000 GBP from the departments of innovation at the Technological Institute of Denmark and Technological University (DTU) for my innovative software project developing a simple GUI that can be navigated by the use of human memory.

From 2000 to 2004, I was employed with Nordea Bank as UX designer and concept developer. The usability test scored top points and clients sent messages to the bank to praise the new design of the online stock trading system. The bank's portfolio managers in Luxembourg were encouraged by and very satisfied with the system's usability.



Meeting the computer screen at university in 1996 with my film-making background, I immediately saw that the GUI and all its 'bad habits' needed some tidying up.

Today, I find that, as the trend of AI is advancing, there is a growing need to keep user interface design for humans. I make the GUIs logical, attractive and with a good flow, and at the same time I put an emphasis on exploiting the possibilities for a good overview and for multi tasking.






A selection of my icon designs above.



Background



I was trained in the Danish and English film and TV industries, from clapper/loader to producer (DR, Nordisk Film, Thames TV, LWT, C4, Trans World Int., Pinewood Studios) as an apprentice and freelance worker.

In 1988 I went on a study tour to Paris, showing my first film "The Umbrella" to French audiences and studying with "Gaumont" and fringe media companies.

I have made several hundred films portraying people and enterprises, bringing messages across and always with a touch of cinematic poetry, which was a brand that I was given by the London-based poet Victoria Kingsley Parker, when she came to my film premiere of The Umbrella in The Everyman Cinema in Hampstead in 1988.

In 1996, I studied for 2 years at the Technological University of Denmark (Human Factors in Telecommunication and IT Technologies) and this gave me a great new set of opportunities for exploiting my creativity.


Christian Blues Band

Ideas behind my work

We, who have worked, sweated and innovated within the industry of IT development, communication and media, for over four decades, understand that it is the human brain and heart driven tools that prevail, while all other propped up marketing tricks have a short life in the real world. Today's challenge is that the marketing and cohersion into using machine driven, part labeled AI, designs and workflows is now so massive (the peak before the collapse), that these methods can be difficult to circumvent.

Many experienced User Experience designers (UX) see every day how the machine and alleged 'business' driven decisions and style of development work is a massive waste of time and ressources, as the original business requirements still stand, the customer's needs are still the same and yet the concluding software development requirement specification is never fullfilled, just anticipated with the lowest denominator of 'being seen to fullfil the contract' and thus the overall technological structure (the software architecture) quickly does not fit the future, the functionalities are not complete and of a low quality and they do not speak to each other. Well, and then there is the questions of usability. Is the Graphic User Interface (GUI) and the User experience (UX) meant to be made for humans or made to be the most practical for machine processing? Let's make it human:)
